



Anne Greenough is Professor of Neonatology and Clinical Respiratory Physiology and Head of King's College London School of Medicine. She is also Director of Education and Training at King's Heath Partners Academic Health Science Centre and Board Member of the Higher Education Funding Council for England. She was Chair of the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Paediatrics (non medicines) Specialty Group and is now Vice President Science and Research, Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health. She is an NIHR Senior Investigator. Professor Greenough is a member of the KCL Research Division of Asthma, Allergy and Lung Biology and the Medical Research Council-Asthma UK Centre in Allergic Mechanisms of Asthma. Her research interests include antenatal lung growth, optimisation of respiratory support, sudden infant death syndrome and prevention and treatment of chronic lung disease.
