Bert Koletzko is Professor of Paediatrics at Ludwig-Maximilians-University of Munich and serves as Consultant Paediatrician and Head of the Div. of Metabolic & Nutritional Medicine, Dr. von Hauner Children's Hospital, Univ. of Munich Medical Center, München, Germany. During his training he worked at paediatric departments in Detmold and Düsseldorf (Germany), Johannesburg-Soweto (South Africa), Moshi (Tanzania) and Toronto (Canada). The research of his group focusses on the biochemistry of nutrition, nutrient gene interactions, metabolic programming of health, obesity, and related areas. Bert has served as co-ordinator of several large research collaborations, such as the current Early Nutrition Project with collaborators across Europe, Australia and the USA (project-earlynutrition.eu). His work has been funded i.a. by the European Commission, the European Research Council, the German Research Council, the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research, and the Norwegian Seafood Council. Bert published more than 770 journal articles (14 565 times cited, H-index 61), 193 book chapters, and 34 books and monographies. He serves as Editor in Chief of *Ann Nutr Metab* and of *World Rev Nutr Diet*, and as Associate Editor of *Current Opinion Clin Nutrition Metabolic Care* and *Monatsschrift Kinderheilkunde*. Among his leadership roles are chair, Committee on Nutrition, German Society Paediatrics (dgkj.de), chair, Child Health Foundation (kindergesundheit.de), Managing Director, Early Nutrition Academy (early-nutrition.org) and chair, Scientific Committee, German National Network Young Families (gesund-ins-leben.de). He was received several awards and honors, including recently Rank Lecture Award, The Nutrition Society, Arved Wretling Lecture Award, European Society Clinical Nutrition Metabolism, Visiting Professor at Univ. Granada and Poznan and honorary doctoral degrees from Univ. Pecs and Univ. Granada.
